Our Policy

At Raukkan Aboriginal School we encourage the wearing of uniform. It is compulsory to wear school uniform when participating in excursions, as it makes students easily identifiable in crowds and, if lost, identifies the school to be contacted.

School uniform plays a key role in promoting pride, self-confidence, and a feeling of belonging within the student body. These factors contribute to students' wellbeing, removing the additional pressures of deciding what to wear and added stress of meeting the expectations of their peers. Uniforms actually cost less than a normal wardrobe. It may seem that some individual uniform items are expensive but when compared to having a whole wardrobe of different outfits, the overall price is much smaller. And school uniforms are generally made of tougher, more durable, fabrics.
