The external school review lines of inquiry focus on:

- quality school improvement planning
- expert teaching
- quality leadership
- conditions for optimal learning

The overarching question in every external school review is: How well does the school improve achievement, growth, challenge, engagement, and equity?

Impact of directions from the previous External School Review.

Raukkan Aboriginal School is a small rural school with a welcoming, caring, positive culture that is underpinned by wellbeing for learning. The staff at Raukkan Aboriginal School are committed to improving their practice and work collaboratively to improve the learning outcomes for students.

Outcomes from the External School Review On-Track Evaluation held October 2022.

The principal will work with the Education Director to implement the following directions:

- Direction 1 Continue to engage in ongoing review and evaluation of the SIP to inform teacher practice and improve outcomes for students.
- Direction 2 Empower students to understand their learning data, to identify the next steps in their learning and develop personalised learning goals.
- Direction 3 Provide opportunities for all students to be engaged and challenged in their learning through embedding agreed effective pedagogical practices including oral language and Ngarrindjeri culture, history and language.

These directions are published on the school improvement plan and will support the school's ongoing improvement work.

Based on current performance, Raukkan Aboriginal School will return to a 3-year review cycle. As a result, the next full external school review under the new cycle will be in 2023.
